**SPARE BOAT OFFER**

To be eligible both the Primary and Spare boats **MUST** be registered to the same member. A copy of the Registration papers **MUST** be supplied prior to membership being accepted.

Spare Boats may be registered for no additional membership fee, and compete in any appropriate event/race, as long as the Primary & Spare Boats are NOT used simultaneously.

The SRA Boat Levy applies to both the Primary, Spare, and additional Boats.

Spare Boats **MUST** be scrutineered and registered with SRA in advance.

2nd Boats (i.e. boats that will compete at the same time as a Primary Boat) are due the fee relevant to their Speed and/or Event Restriction.

- CPR Certificate Minimum HTLAID – All Competitors aged 13 & over. Completed within the last 24 months.**  
Online First Aid questions –During each twelve (12) month period that an accredited CPR course is NOT completed, all Competitors aged 13 and over are required to complete the SRA Online First Aid Questionnaire
- Working With Children Check – All Competitors aged 18 & over.**
- Completed Ski Racing Australia Medical Form - All competitors aged 18 & over**

## SPARE BOAT POLICY 2024

The SRA Board have implemented a policy that permits Spare Boats to be utilised at no additional cost. The specifics of this change are defined below.

### Definitions

Owner	The person or entity that all <sup>1</sup> of the boats are registered to.
Primary Boat	The Owner's boat that will compete at the highest Speed Restriction.
Additional Boat/s	The Owner's boat/s that will compete at the same time as the Primary Boat or Spare Boat.
Spare Boat	The Owner's boat that may NOT compete at the same time <sup>2</sup> as the Primary Boat. Note: Regardless of how many Additional Boats any Owner may have they are only entitled to ONE Spare Boat in any individual race.

<sup>1</sup> A Spare Boat MUST be registered to the **same Owner** of the Primary Boat. A copy of the Boat Registration papers MUST be provided prior to the Boat Membership being accepted.

<sup>2</sup> If a Spare Boat is found to have competed at the same time as a Primary Boat the Owner will be immediately liable for the Season Membership Fee applicable to the Tier that the Spare Boat competed in to record the breach, regardless of the duration of the breach or the stage of the season.

### Example 1

An Owner may use both their Primary and Spare Boats at a Point Score or Series event as long as the two boats are never in the same race or otherwise competing at the same time. E.g., The Primary Boat can compete in Race 6 and then the Spare Boat can compete in Race 7. Note: if Races 6 & 7 are combined by the Race Director than either the Primary or Spare Boat must withdraw.

### Example 2

An Owner may use both their Primary and Spare Boats at a Classic River Event as long as the two boats are never competing at the same time and the crew can reasonably pilot both boats. E.g. The Primary Boat can be used in a Social Class on Saturday morning and the Spare Boat can be used to tow an U10 in the afternoon.
